

## DEVELOPMENTAL FOOTBALL INTERNATIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

**DFI** is dedicated to developing and mentoring young men through the advancement of athletic skills and education.

Participation in the organization's programs is subject to the observance of the organization's rules and procedures. *The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited*. Any participant or staff member who violates this Code is subject to consequences, up to and including removal from the program.

- Abusive language towards fans, coaches, staff members, volunteers or other participants.
- Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on any property where the DFI play, practice or conduct business, or reporting to any team activity while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Exceptions include approved team activities where alcohol is legally served (i.e., restaurants, private cookouts, et al).
- Bringing any dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items onto any and all property owned or used by DFI, including fields, locker rooms, offices, doctors offices, or training facilities,
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, fan, coach, staff member or volunteer.
- Verbal, physical or visual harassment of another participant, fan, coach, staff member or volunteer.
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to follow any DFI policy or procedure.
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.
- Failing to cooperate with coaches, instructors, supervisors or mentors.
